## PROCEDURES AND RULES FOR USE OF STADIUM

**Woodlands Warriors Basketball Club in partnership with Woodlands Primary School requires the following procedures and rules to be adhered to. It will be the responsibility of either the team manager or another parent to make sure these are followed.**

The club is now responsible for paying an annual Bond to the school. If any incidents of any damages that are reported by the school during the timeslot that your team is allocated, that incurs any cost to the school, your team will be asked to cover any costs.

### **Rules that must be adhered to:**

- Access to the hall prior to school is from 8.00 – 8.30am.
- There must be atleast 1 other parent (apart from the coach) present at training. It is their responsibility to make sure they rules are abided by.
- Access to the hall after school is 3.45pm. This allows the staff to pack and lock-up interior doors.  
Hall must not be accessed before staff have packed up and locked the door to the foyer
- On days when it is raining, you may access the hall from 3.30pm.  
Please ensure staff have completed packing and locking up interior doors. If they haven't please assist them to pack up.
- Any equipment that is left out is not to be touched in any way. Parents please inform your children that due to safety issues they must keep off the equipment.
- While waiting to access the hall, children are not allowed to bounce their ball against the entrance wall
- Make sure children wipe their feet before entering to reduce the amount of dirt on the court.
- Only correct non-marking footwear to be worn. Any students with incorrect footwear should be asked not to train by their coach.
- Toilets are not locked. However we ask that they checked before and after training, to make sure they are in satisfactory condition.
- NO FOOD AND DRINK are allowed in the stadium at all. Children requiring a drink during training may do so outside the main door.  
Parents that have other siblings with them must make sure they also adhere to these rules
- EMERGENCY DOOR MUST NOT BE USED AT ANY TIME. This must be strictly supervised.  
Please make sure it is shut correctly from the OUTSIDE before you training session finishes.  
If this door is not shut correctly it can trigger the alarm
- Any parents that have other siblings that are not training, they must be present. No unsupervised children will be allowed in the stadium. Only children training are allowed on the court.  
Any other children that enter the stadium must be asked to leave.
- The club will provide a full roster of teams that are in the hall each week (which the school will have a copy of)
- At the end of training the court must be swept and the brooms shaken outside.
- The form in the broom cupboard must be filled out by one person from the team that sweeps the floor
- The form must be filled by every team. Those that do not follow procedure will first be warned by the club. If they continue to not follow the procedures their team will no longer be allowed to use the stadium.
